Santa Helena Sauvignon Blanc 2009/10, Chile **£14.50**
Fresh and vibrant Chilean Sauvignon. Juicy green fruit on the nose and a zingy, refreshing palate. 175ml - £3.75 250ml - £5.25

Mannara Pinot Grigio / Grillo 2009, Italy **£15.50**
Cracking Pinot Grigio here with plenty citrus fruit on the nose and a crisp and juicy palate. 175ml - £4.00 250ml - £5.50

Santa Helena Cabernet Rose 2009, Chile **14.50**
Fuller style of rose with stacks of red fruit aromas and rounded palate. 175ml - £3.75 250ml - £5.25

Santa Helena Merlot 2008/09, Chile **£14.50**
Juicy little red here with blackcurrant and spice on the nose and an easy drinking palate. 175ml - £3.75 250ml - £5.25

Candidato Tempranillo 2008/09, Spain **£15.00**
Bursting with berry fruits (strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant), and a creamy note on the nose. Full-bodied and fresh with hints of candy, and a long, complex finish. 175ml - £3.85 250ml - £5.40

Gran Hacienda Chardonnay 2009, Chile **£16.50**
With full aromas of tropical fruit, green apples and zesty orange peel this cheeky little white is guaranteed to please. The palate is fresh and fruity with a yummy finish.

Baron Philippe Rothschild Viognier 2008/09, France **£17.00**
Juicy pineapple and racy acidity combine to give a clean and refreshing wine.

Torres San Valentín-Parellada 2007/08, Spain **£18.00**
Fruity and aromatic with juicy aromas of fresh grapes and bananas. The palate is soft and juicy with a touch of sweetness.

Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac 2008/09, France **£19.00**
Aromatic and subtle, showing stoned fruit on the nose. The palate is clean and fresh with flavours of lemon, apple and peach. Lush!

Stoneburn Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2008/09, New Zealand **£21.50**
Wonderfully aromatic Kiwi Sauvignon with ripe aromas of gooseberry, lime and green pepper. The palate is juicy, clean and elegant.

Chablis Victor Berard 2008, France **£25.00**
Clear, bright and fresh, everything you want from Chablis. The palate has crisp green fruit, a wonderful mouth-feel, with balance and versatility.

Mannara Pinot Grigio Rose 2008/09 **£17.00**
Crisp and fruity with notes of ripe melon and strawberry. Super easy drinking and doesn't touch the sides.

Wild Boar Rose, Chateau Routas 2008/09 **£21.50**
Elegant southern French rose with a fantastic colour! Packed with strawberry aromas and a refreshingly juicy palate.

Cape Dream Pinotage 2007/08 **£16.00**
Juicy bramble fruit aromas move to a rich palate with a smooth and classy finish.

Finca la Colonia Malbec 2008/09, Argentina **£17.00**
Sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish.

Sacred Hill Shiraz / Cabernet 2008/09, Australia **£18.00**
Typical ozzy Shiraz Cab! Juicy nose of black fruit and spice and a well structured and fuller palate.

Castel Firmian Merlot, Mezzacorona 2007, Italy **£19.00**
Intense fragrance with a mixture of ripe fruits and a hint of oak. Dry,

complex and well-structured palate. A stunning wine from a brilliant producer.

Paternina Banda Azul Crianza Rioja 2006, Spain **£22.00**
Rock and roll Rioja! Full on aromas of juicy redcurrant and bramble fruit move to a rich and robust palate with heaps of class!

Chateau La Clyde Rouge, 1er Cotes de Bordeaux 2004, France **£25.00**
An elegant and developed wine with aromas of plum and soft spice. The palate is smooth and silky with a classic Bordeaux style.

Pol Gesse Brut NV **£30.00**
Pure notes of lemon and vanilla on the nose move to a juicy and full palate.

Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Rizzardi NV **£22.50**
Easily one of the best Proseccos available. Wonderfully pure aromas of citrus and apple fruit move to a delicate and decadent palate!

Rizzardi Pinot Grigio di Veneto IGT 2008/09, Italy **£22.50**
Pinot Grigio the way it should be! Full and superbly balanced aromas of peach, pear and apple moving to a faultless palate with rounded fruit character and a refreshing acidity.

Rizzardi Valpolicella Classico DOC 2008/09, Italy **£23.50**
A complex nose of red and black cherries with spice and earthy notes. The palate is round and rich with good structure. Like the people of Valpolicella, this wine packs a punch!

Capercaillie 'The Cullin' Chardonnay 2008/09, Australia **£30.00**
Named in honour of our famous 'Cullin' hills of Skye, this wine needs a pair of boots to scale! Full on toasty Chardonnay with beautiful aromas of rich apple and pear fruit, leading to a complex and rewarding finish.

Capercaillie 'The Clan' 2007, Australia **£32.00**
Based on a Bordeaux blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petit Verdot, this biddy is real 'Gathering' of class! Strong cassis aromas mingle with pronounced spicy notes then move to a full and satisfying palate!
